

Rx Open House Compliance, Educational, and Sponsorship Disclosure

Educational Purpose

Rx Open House is an independent educational and professional engagement platform intended to facilitate disease-state education, healthcare collaboration, and informational exchange among healthcare professionals, industry participants, and clinical stakeholders.

Programs, presentations, educational events, and discussions hosted through Rx Open House are intended solely for informational and educational purposes and are not intended to promote, recommend, induce, or require the prescription, purchase, referral, or use of any specific pharmaceutical product, biologic, medical device, therapy, or healthcare service.

Educational Independence Policy

Rx Open House is committed to maintaining the independence and integrity of educational programming.

Educational content is developed independently and is intended to remain evidence-based, clinically relevant, disease-state focused, and free from sponsor control over independent clinical judgment.

Participating sponsors do not control clinical conclusions, speaker opinions, educational outcomes, attendee participation, or independent healthcare decision-making.

Sponsor Participation & Access Policy

Clinical Independence Statement

Sponsors do not determine whether educational events occur, which topics are presented, or which healthcare professionals participate as speakers.

Rx Open House may review educational materials, presentations, and programming

Attendee Participation Policy
